How does it work?

The mathematics teaching and learning in **Becoming 1stClass@Number** has been carefully structured to develop and deepen children’s number sense in relation to numbers up to 20.

This covers mathematical subject knowledge, pedagogy and adapting session plans to meet children’s needs.

The training runs over 1 full day and 5 half days for the TA, and a school Link Teacher attends two of these half-day sessions to support the TA in managing and evaluating the scheme.
